

Kinder Goat Breeders Association Board of Directors Meeting
August 19, 2024

The meeting was called to order by the president, Ashley Kennedy. Brandon Anthony was not in attendance due to work.

Minutes were discussed with the following suggestion made to improve the minutes: In situations where names are the same, use last names to know who is involved in discussions, making motions, etc. Ashley Kennedy offered to correct last month's minutes, and Sue Beck suggested the same. Lisa Lamm suggested it would only involve the Lisas. A motion was made to approve the minutes pending corrections.

The treasurer's report was reviewed and discussed. Sue Beck made a motion to approve the report. Katherine second the motion. The report was approved.
